There may be metal shavings or other debris from the previous pump failure that are being circulated back into the pump, causing the new pump to fail. 2. Power Steering Pump A failing power steering pump. The power steering pump is a common reason your Chrysler Town and Country might whine when accelerating. If it gets too low on fluid, it''ll whine a lot. Check the fluid level and fill it back up to the factory fill line.

I had asked the parts guy and he gave me power steering fluid (he said it was Dexron II) which I put in, only to find out belatedly it's ???



@Canadacaravan I used the same approach as you (ie. suck it out, fill it up, turn the steering wheel a lot, rinse & repeat) on my Ford Focus last summer. I doubt the Focus' power steering system holds much more than your van - if I were to bet, I'd say it held less than your van. The power steering fluid was terribly old and super dark.



Flushing The Power Steering System. Completely flushing the power steering system requires some technical know-how and can be a mess. It's also helpful to have a helper on hand. Disconnect the low-pressure return hose and direct it into a bucket or drain pan. You probably will need a length of hose to reach the pan.





You can often alleviate these issues with a power steering flush. Using some chemicals from Trans-X, your old power steering pump can be refreshed. This particular product is called Slip-Stop, and is designed for transmissions. Because the power steering pump is hydraulic in nature, this will work for it as well.
