

Tip: Try to buy more power steering fluid than you need as you will use some to flush and clean the power steering system.

Bleeding the power steering system. The usual suspect in power steering fluid leaks is the power steering pressure hose. In the process of fixing where the air gets in, it's easy to introduce some more. After replacing a power steering pump or pressure hose, it's always a good plan to flush and bleed the power steering system of air.

When replacing a leaking or damaged power steering cooler on a 2008-2012 Enclave, 2009-2012 Traverse, 2007-2012 Acadia or 2007-2010 Outlook, it is critical to replace the cooler without introducing a lot of air into the system. When replacing a power steering cooler, first block off the hoses near the cooler connection with the appropriate clamps.
