

What should Planet 9 be named if it is found?

The researchers who spotted the planet would like to see it called "George" after King George III, in a nod to a British astronomer who discovered Uranus and had hoped to name it Georgium Sidus (the Georgian Planet). However, it's unclear that the public would embrace "George," which lacks the whimsy of our original ninth planet.

Are there more than 9 planets?

Until direct evidence of a 9th planet is observed there are only 8 planets we have direct evidence of in our solar system as of 2016 (Pluto isn't a planet and we haven't yet confirmed Planet 9). The sun is a star. From the sun outward we have: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune.

What is the ninth planet name?

This hypothetical Neptune-sized planet orbits our Sun in a highly elongated orbit far beyond Pluto. The object, which the researchers have nicknamed "Planet Nine," could have a mass about 10 times that of Earth and orbit about 20 times farther from the Sun on average than Neptune.



The four outer planets are Jupiter, Saturn, Neptune, and Uranus, giant planets that consist mainly of either gases or ice. Pluto was considered the ninth planet until 2006, when the International Astronomical Union voted to a?

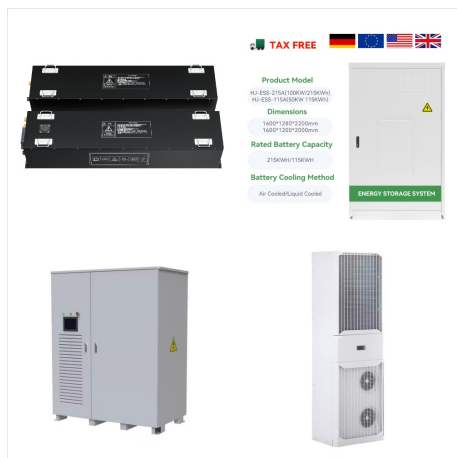

Planets, asteroids, and comets orbit our Sun. They travel around our Sun in a flattened circle called an ellipse. It takes the Earth one year to go around the Sun. Mercury goes around the Sun in only 88 days. It takes Pluto, the most famous dwarf planet, 248 years to make one trip around the Sun. Moons orbit planets.



Of the nine planets, only seven are actually gods and the other two, Rahu and Ketu are demons. The seven are usually spoken as planets, while the two are compared to comets and the like, having a shadowy influence upon the destinies of people. The names for the seven days in the week are derived from the planetary gods.
