An acrostic poem is one in which a certain feature -- for example, the first letter -- from every line combines to spell out a message -- usually the name of the subject, for instance the person to whom the acrostic poem is dedicated. Example: An acrostic poem for Tom



Acrostic poetry is a form of short verse constructed so that the initial letters of each line taken consecutively form words. The term is derived from the Greek words akros, "at the end," and stichos, "line." The word acrostic was first applied to the prophecies of the Erythraean Sibyl, which were written on leaves and arranged so that the

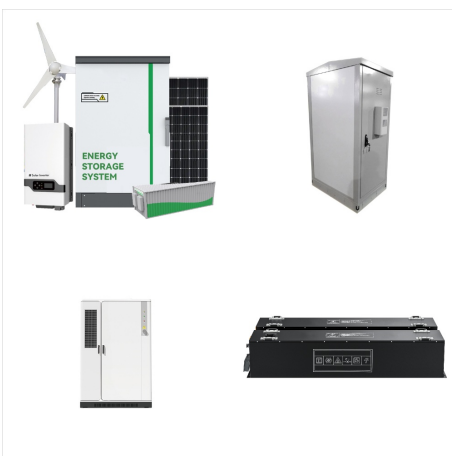
