

Where is the battery/charging icon in Windows 10?

After upgrading to Windows 10 the battery/charging icon is missing from the system tray. Under Settings, System, Notifications & actions, Turn system icons on or off, the Power switch is grayed out. In the Notifications & actions, Select which icons appear on the taskbar, the Power icon is on but does not show in the taskbar.

How do I add a battery icon to my taskbar?

To add the battery icon to the taskbar: Select Start > Settings > Personalization > Taskbar, and then scroll down to Notification area. Select Select which icons appear on the taskbar, and then turn on the Power toggle. Note: The Power toggle is not visible on a system such as a desktop PC that doesn't use battery power.

How do I Turn on the battery icon on Windows 10?

Select its toggle switch to set it to On. You should now see the battery icon in the taskbar. If, when you select the up arrow, the battery icon isn't in the group of hidden icons, it means you'll need to enable the battery icon. Go into the Taskbar settings using one of the methods described above.

Does Windows 10 have a power icon?

If the Power option here is grayed out, Windows 10 thinks you're using a desktop PC without a battery. The taskbar's power icon won't appear on PCs without a battery. Even after you've restored the battery icon, it won't show an estimate of the remaining battery time when you mouse over it.

How do I fix a missing battery/charging icon in Windows 10?

Go to device manager: Right click on: Microsoft ACPI-Compliant Control Method Battery Select: update driver software Click: search automatically Hope this helps. Thanks. After upgrading to Windows 10 the battery/charging icon is missing from the system tray.

Does Windows 10 have a battery icon?

Once toggled, the battery icon should immediately appear on your taskbar. If it doesn't, you might need to restart your computer for the changes to take effect. After completing these steps, the battery icon should be

visible on your Windows 10 taskbar, allowing you to easily keep an eye on your battery life.



After you complete the steps, the settings will apply, and the System Tray will only show the icons you left enabled. Turn Windows 10 apps icons on and off from Taskbar. To add or remove system icons from the Taskbar notification area, use these steps: Open Settings (Windows key + I). Click on Personalization. Click on Taskbar.

At the moment of this writing, Windows 10 has a working Registry tweak which, when applied, allows you to switch between the old and new battery applet. How to Enable or Disable System Icons on Taskbar in Windows 10 The Clock, Volume, Network, Power, and Action Center system icons are located on the taskbar notification area (aka: system tray) by default in Windows. When you hover over these icons, you can see their status. You can right click on these icons to access specific options or settings for them.

With default settings, Windows 10 displays a battery icon in the system tray area of the taskbar. The battery icon on the taskbar gives a rough idea about the current status of the battery's charge level, but it's hard to make out the actual remaining battery capacity by having a look at the battery icon.
