How much does solar cost in South Carolina?

The average price per watt of solar power in South Carolina is \$2.44/W. These prices are before incentives. After the federal solar tax credit, the final cost will drop by 30%, down to \$21,873 for a 12.82 kW system. Many states even offer local rebates and incentives that lower the price further--sometimes by thousands of dollars.

Does South Carolina have solar energy?

Since only about three percentof homes are powered by solar in the state, this puts the priority for the changeover relatively low compared to how many clear days residents enjoy each year. That being said, South Carolina's solar energy still falls in the top half of the country's stats when it comes to price.

What tax credits are available for solar installation in South Carolina?

A 25%tax credit on solar installation in South Carolina with a maximum credit of either \$3,500 or 50% of your state tax liability over 10 years. Net metering programs that allow residents to sell excess power back to the local power company. Local utility company incentives to offset the costs of installation.

How much do solar panels cost per state?
