

Also known as a materials warranty, an inverter product warranty covers the integrity of the equipment itself. If your solar inverter has a defect or mechanical issue or experiences unreasonable wear and tear, that's where your product warranty comes into play.

Do solar installers offer a warranty?

Most solar installers also offer equipment warranties of up to 25 yearson parts like panels, inverters, and racking systems. While production guarantees are often referred to as "production warranties," as the name implies, they cover the actual production of a customer's system, not the physical materials.

What is the warranty period for the inverter?

The default warranty period for the STANDARD, ASSURE and accessories integrated into the inverter is 5 yearsstarting from the installation/commissioning date but in any case not longer than +66 months from manufacturing date. The default warranty period for accessories sold separately is 2 years starting from the manufacturing date.

Does Fimer offer a warranty for Aurora PVI solar systems?

Fimer will honor the terms of the product warrantyfor the Aurora PVI model units used in SunPower solar systems and ensure product availability to service warranty claims at this time. ABB/Aurora inverters are typically supplied with a 5 year warranty. If your system was commissioned within the last 5 years you should contact your original installer or ABB directly. Beyond 5 years it is still worth checking with ABB and some inverters would have been supplied with a 10 year warranty at the point of installation.



Solar inverters are guaranteed for a period ranging from 3 to 10 years, with an average standard warranty period of 5 years. Some companies offer the possibility to extend this period. The warranty start date varies according to the manufacturer: it can be the date of production, the date of purchase, or else the delivery or installation date.
