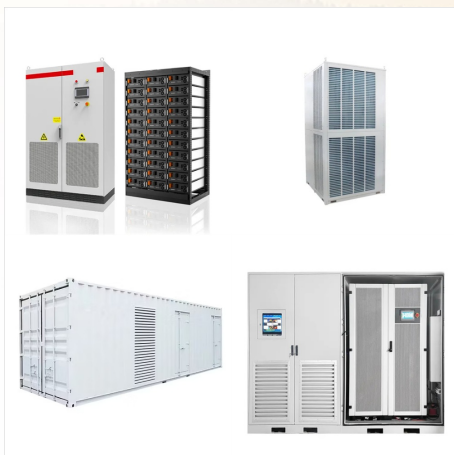

Aventine Renewable Energy Inc., a producer, marketer and end-to-end supplier of ethanol, has announced its first railcar shipment of ethanol produced at its Aurora West facility in Aurora, Nebraska, using sugar-based only feedstock.



Later in October 2007, Aventine Renewable Energy (now," Pacific Ethanol Aurora West) received a Prevention of Significant Deterioration permit to construct a large ethanol plant just west of the grain cooperative. The project was permitted as an expansion to the Nebraska Energy ethanol plant which was acquired by Aventine.
