

The average cost of solar in the U.S. is \$31,558,based on the latest cumulative data from the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory,a Department of Energy Office of Science laboratory. Solar panel costs are calculated by the price per watt. The average price per watt in the U.S. is \$3.67 for an 8.6 kW system (rounded up).

How much does solar energy cost per watt?

The cost per watt is what you pay for each unit of power of your solar energy system. Think of it a little like "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes. As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84.

How much does a 5 kilowatt solar system cost?

The average 5-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system is \$14,210before considering any financial incentives. However,a typical American household needs a system closer to 10 kW to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2024. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.

The cost of a solar PV module make up the largest part of the total investment costs. As per the recent analysis of Solar Power Generation Costs in Japan 2021, module unit prices fell sharply. In 2018, the average price was close to 60,000 yen/kW, but by 2021 it is estimated at 30,000 yen/kW, so cost is reduced by almost half.

Solar panel installation costs a national average of \$16,500 for a 6kW solar panel system for a 1,500 square ft. home. Residential solar panels are usually sized at 3kW to 8kW and can cost anywhere from \$9,255 and \$28,000 in total installation costs.
