



How to export SharePoint list data in power automate?

Create a new flow in Power Automate. Choose a trigger, such as "When an item is created or modified". Add an action, selecting "Get items" to retrieve the SharePoint list data. Configure the Excel action, specifying the Excel file and sheet to export the data.

How to get all items from SharePoint list to power automate flow?

Get Items operation will fetch all the items from the given SharePoint list to the Power Automate flow. We will provide the Get Items action's parameters like the site and list detail with the Sharepoint site and list name from where we want to get all the items.

How do I use power automate in SharePoint?

Power Automate appears under the Automate menu on the command bar in SharePoint libraries and OneDrive for work or school on the web. In lists, the Power Automate option appears on the Integrate menu. For SharePoint, the option to create a flow will only be available for site members who can add and edit items.

How to export a list in power automate?

And due to its simple format the list can be exported much faster than into an Excel file. Power Automate has even a dedicated action to create a .csv file from an array. It's called 'Create CSV table' and the input must be an array. Then you can select if you want to export all columns (Automatic) or only some of them (Custom).

How to create a power automate flow in SharePoint?

We will provide a name for the flow and click on the " create " button. Let's move forward and add the next step in this Power Automate flow. Next, we will add the ' Get Items ' of SharePoint action from the operators of Power Automate. Get Items operation will fetch all the items from the given SharePoint list to the Power Automate flow.







However, I have followed the steps in my flow but couldn't save the flow as it turned me with "Flow save failed with code "InvalidTemplate" and message "The template validation failed: "The action(s) "Get items" referenced by "inputs" in action "Condition" are not defined in the template."."



It is a common task to save a copy of an email message to SharePoint as backup. With Power Automate, we can save incoming/outgoing email messages and their attachments to a SharePoint Document library. We also have the option to place the email message in a folder or add metadata to make it easier to find later on.



Any JSON array containing the data that you want to insert into SharePoint will be fine. The Standard Power Automate Method. The most often used method to import rows of data into SharePoint with Power Automate is to use an apply to each loop to iterate through a JSON array using a "Create Item" action within the loop.


