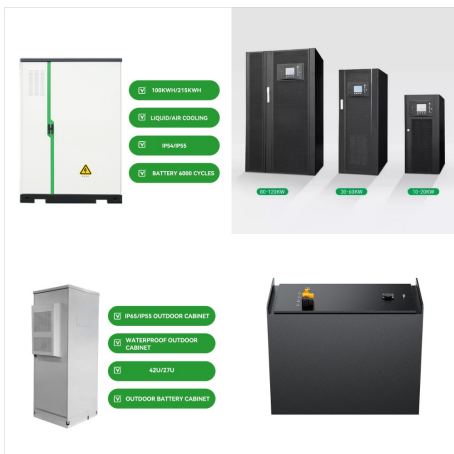

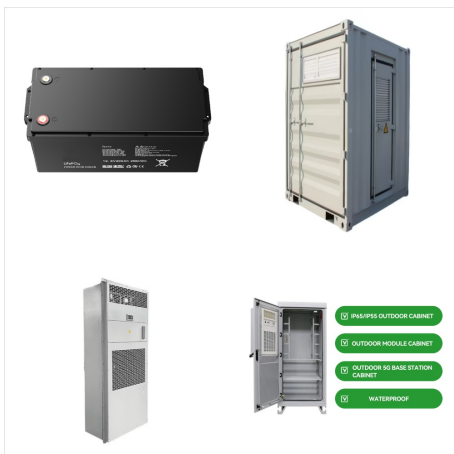

If you have a MacBook using macOS Ventura 13, the steps below will help you pair it to Beats Solo 3 headphones. Click the Apple menu and navigate to System Settings > Bluetooth. The headphones will appear among the available Bluetooth devices named "Beats Solo3."

I downloaded the beats updater but that says they're perfectly fine. Is there any way to reset them or fix this in another way (other than holding the power button and pause button)?



Another alternative to connecting the Beats Solo 3 headphones to your Android is to use the Beats app. Once you download it from the play store, open it, agree to the Apple privacy policy, and tap Get Started.
