How does state authority work in Belarus?

The state authority in the Republic of Belarus is exercised on the basis of separation of powers into legislative, executive and judicial branches. Essentially, this principle prevents concentration of all power in the hands of one particular government body, it is instead divided between three branches of government.

How many government units are there in Belarus?

Executive power at the national level is concentrated in the government, through the Council of Ministers (Soviet Ministrov,???????????????) made up of 24 functional and sectoral Ministries and 7State Committees. There are 6 regions and the city of Minsk which serve as the 7 regional administrative units in Belarus.

How does the Republic of Belarus deal with military aggression?

The Republic of Belarus rules out military aggression from its territoryin relation to other states. The main vectors of domestic and foreign policies were approved by framework laws adopted by the Parliament.

What does the President do in Belarus?

Person's legal status: the President makes decisions about granting and terminating the citizenship of the Republic of Belarus and about giving asylum; pardons convicts.

Is Belarus a democratic state?

The Republic of Belarus is a unitary democratic welfare and rule-of-law state. The Republic of Belarus exercises supreme control and absolute authority over its territory and implements its domestic and foreign policies in an independent manner.




