An Albanian who says besa once cannot in any way break [his]promise and cannot be unfaithful [to it]. -- Mehmed Ferid Pasha, Ottoman-Albanian grand vizier, (1903) Besa is a word in the Albanian language meaning pledge of honor.

Besa is considered by Albanians as their moral testimony and a fundamental virtue inherited by ancient ancestors. The concept of "Besa" (also known as the 'cult of Besa') is one of the most important manners of conduct for Albanians, as it is related to the cult of honor.

What is the ancient Albanian code of Besa?

The Albanian word besa is an Indo-European cognate and shares similarities with the Classical Latin word fides.

Where did the word 'besa' come from?

According to many scholars, 'Besa' has derived from the biblical quote "In the beginning, there was the Word". Albanologist studies say that 'Besa' derives from Kanun, known as the first legal system of Albanian people, a set of 12 books that contain a series of traditional laws. Kanun was the highest authority for the people of Albania.

Why did Albania make a besa during the Great Eastern Crisis?

During the Great Eastern Crisis, Albanians gathered in Prizren, Kosovo (1878) and made a besa to form a political alliance (League of Prizren) aimed at upholding Ottoman territorial integrity to prevent the partition of Albanian lands by neighbouring Balkan countries.






