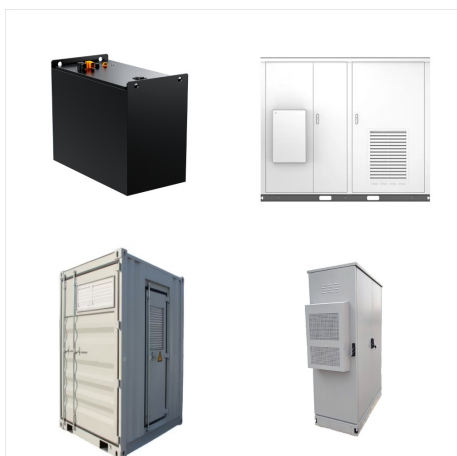
Best Friends are the friends you Snap and Chat with the most! They're featured front-and-center on the Send To screen, and the Chat section of your profile ! You can have up to eight Best Friends, and they're updated regularly.



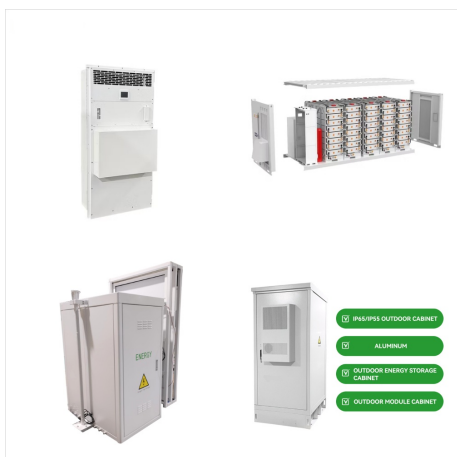
Do you want to make someone your Best Friend on Snapchat? Best Friend status on Snapchat is indicated by a special Friend Emoji by their name and determined by how often you exchange Snaps with a user. You can easily streamline the Best Friend status by focusing your activity with a specific user.



We have long celebrated friendships with what we call "Friend Emojis" that appear based on the way you and your friends use Snapchat. These emojis change regularly based on the way you interact, and are private to you and your friend.



Your Best Friends on Snapchat are the eight people you chat and Snap with most. Snapchat displays your Best Friends at the top of both the Chats and Send To screens, making it super easy to keep up your favorite conversations.



Pink hearts ??? means you have been best friends with a user for two consecutive months (aka Super best friends!). You've been sending the most snaps to each other for 60 consecutive days. Red heart ?? ??? you will see this emoji when you have been exchanging snaps with your #1 best friend for two consecutive weeks. This emoji is an upgrade
