Will Iran face a natural gas shortage this winter?

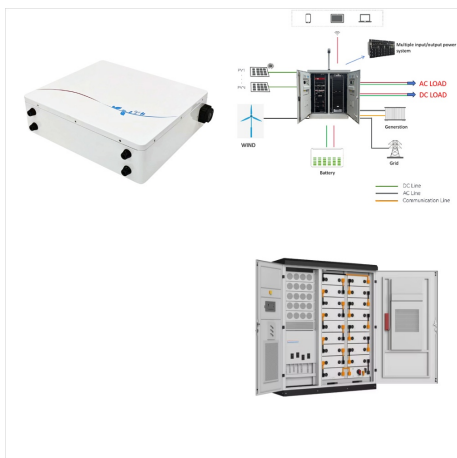

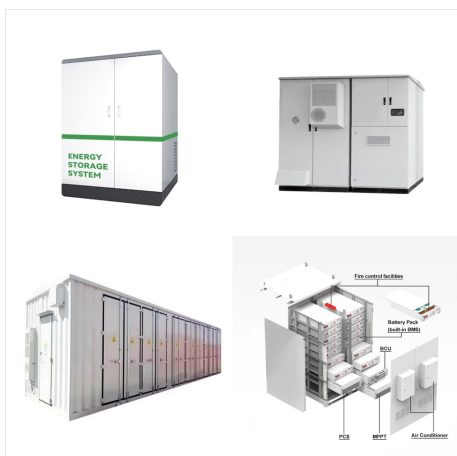
