What is a 100kWh battery system?

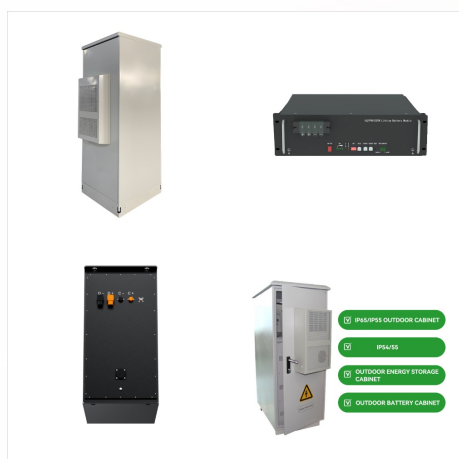

Will CBC invest \$1 billion in a lithium plant in Bolivia?

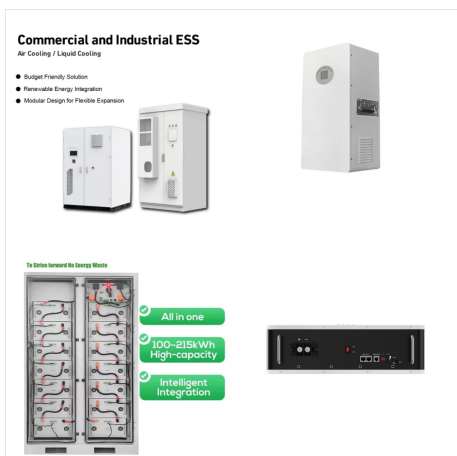
Bolivian President Luis Arce said CBC would invest over \$1 billionin the project's first stage,boosting infrastructure,roads and conditions needed to start up plants the country hopes will one day produce lithium cathodes and batteries. He added that talks were ongoing for potential partnerships with other foreign firms.



To reach the estimated load power demand of 2150 kWh for the studied location, optimized PV/battery configuration sizing required 650 PV modules of 250 W and 715 batteries of 300 Ah.

Therefore, for the optimal point (the top green cross) with 0.99% LPSP and a cost of 6703 USD, the corresponding PV and battery sizes are 2.4 kW p and 4.9 kWh, respectively. By rounding off to available commercial sizes, a system with 2.5 kW p PV module and a battery with 4.8 kWh capacity would be sufficient.



The solar plant has an installed PV capacity of 181.44 kWp, with 336 Jinko 540 Wp PV modules, 140 kW in SMA Sunny Tripower grid inverters, 806 kWh in a lithium battery bank consisting of 60 CEGASA eBick PRO 280 modules with SMA Sunny Island battery inverters.
