Will solar panels be installed at Indian ocean tuna?

operational in 2026, will use the existing cabling for the wind farm to send electricity back to the shore. Meanwhile, Ocean Sun has developed a floating rig, where the solar panels rest on a base which flexes as the waves pass underneath.


