Burkina Faso, also known by its short-form name Burkina, is a landlocked country in West Africa around 274,200 square kilometres (105,900 sq mi) in size.

Does Burkina Faso have a franc?

Burkina Faso is part of the West African Monetary and Economic Union (UMEOA) and has thus adopted the CFA Franc, which is issued by the Central Bank of the West African States (BCEAO), situated in Dakar, Senegal. There is mining of copper, iron, manganese, gold, cassiterite (tin ore), and phosphates.

Is agriculture a problem in Burkina Faso?

Agriculture is a significant contributor to Burkina Faso's economy, accounting for around 31% of its GDP as of 2017. This figure is similar to the one from 2004, indicating some stagnation in the sector. Common crops in Burkina Faso include cotton, sorghum, corn, millet, rice, sesame, and groundnuts.

Does Burkina Faso produce gold?

Burkina Faso does have gold mines, with six gold mines in 2012. However, most of the gold is produced using labor from slaves including child labor. The gold deposits in Burkina Faso are not as high grade as those found in South Africa, but new reserves are being discovered frequently.

Is rice grown in Burkina Faso?

Burkina Faso is a landlocked nation in Africa with an area of about 105,900 square miles. It shares borders with Mali, Benin, Niger, Ghana, Ivory Coast, and Togo. Rice is not explicitly mentioned in the passage as being grown in Burkina Faso. As of July 2018, the United Nations estimated that the population of the country was around 19.8 million people.
