

Lithium-ion batteries and devices containing these batteries should NOT go in household garbage or recycling bins. Lithium-ion batteries SHOULD be taken to separate recycling or household hazardous waste collection points. To prevent fires,tape battery terminals and/or place lithium-ion batteries in separate plastic bags.

Where can I drop off a used lithium ion battery?

Instead,EPA recommends that all household lithium batteries be dropped off at battery collection sites(e.g.,often located at electronics retailers) or household hazardous waste collection facilities for proper management. The EPA Used Lithium-Ion Batteries web page offers resources to find a battery recycling location near you.

How do you dispose of a lithium battery?

Check for the word "lithium" marked on the battery. Do not put button-cell, coin, or lithium single-use batteries in the trash or municipal recycling bins. Check with Earth 911.com to find a recycling location near you. Button-cell or coin batteries can be a potential swallowing hazard. Be certain to store them out of the reach of young children.

Can you put used lithium-ion batteries in the trash?

27% think it is okay to put used lithium-ion batteries in the household trash. Because they contain hazardous materials, they should never be placed in the trash. 54% of US consumers are concerned about what we will do with all these lithium-ion EV batteries after they reach end of life.

Are recycled lithium-ion batteries more expensive?

44% of US consumer think that it is more expensive make new lithium-ion batteries using recycled lithium-ion battery materials. Companies can manufacture new lithium-ion battery materials at a lower cost compared to traditional cathode manufacturing methods.

What should I do if a lithium ion battery gets damaged?

If a lithium-ion battery becomes damaged, contact the battery or device manufacturer for specific handling



information. Look for labels identifying battery chemistry. Do not put rechargeable batteries in the trash or municipal recycling bins. Check with Earth911.com to find a recycling location near you.



It requires specialized recycling facilities to handle the lithium, so you can"t just take any old lithium-ion battery to your local recycling center. With EV sales estimated to rise 35% in 2023, there will be a growing demand for lithium batteries. But other vehicles and systems, like golf carts, marine vehicles and even solar power setups



You must take batteries to an authorized recycling center, a universal waste handler or a household hazardous waste disposal facility. When you know how to dispose of batteries, you can help the environment. Dropoff sites typically accept rechargeable batteries for recycling. For single-use batteries, you can get a mail-order recycling kit.
