Can I ship lithium batteries via the USPS?

Either of these solutions will help you continue to ship lithium battery devices via the USPS in full compliance with the new rules. For a more complete explanation of the Postal Service's rules for shipping lithium batteries, please visit our USPS Publication 52 page.

Can I ship lithium batteries overseas?

For shipping lithium batteries with USPS overseas, you can ship a maximum of 4 cells or 2 batteries that are installed in the new or certified refurbished equipment or device it operates, without any lithium battery markings. However, individual batteries are prohibited from USPS international shipping.

Are lithium batteries safe to ship?

Website Concerns or Feedback: phmsawebsitemanager@dot.gov PHMSA and the U.S. Postal Service collaborated on a set of safety guidelines for those wanting to mail lithium batteries. Persons wishing to ship lithium batteries and electronic devices containing lithium batteries should be aware that certain requirements must be met to ensure safety.

How do I ship a lithium battery?

USPS has official instructions and guidelines for shipping batteries. ShipSaving helps you to highlight the following information: All packages containing lithium metal or lithium-ion batteries that can be mailed must be of sufficient size, sealed, and rigid. This ensures that the lithium battery mark can be affixed to the address without folding.

Can a lithium battery be attached to a mailpiece?

Except for mailpieces containing button cell batteries properly installed in the equipment they are intended to operate, mailpieces containing mailable lithium metal or lithium-ion batteries must be rigid, sealed, and of adequate size, so the lithium battery mark can be affixed to the address side without the mark being folded.

Where can I mail lithium batteries?

Customers can mail packages containing lithium batteries installed in electronic devices to their local Post Office for many international destinations, and Army (APO), Fleet (FPO), and Diplomatic Post Office (DPO)



locations. For the current regulations regarding the mailability of lithium batteries, please visit your local Post Office.



Ensure the country you want to ship to accepts lithium batteries. Check online and look at the shipping policy for lithium batteries for your country. Some areas may restrict you from sending lithium batteries entirely, while others will put ???




Effective July 1, 2015, all existing customers and new customers who wish to ship lithium metal batteries without equipment (UN3090) via UPS (R) Air services must obtain pre-approval from UPS Airlines. For batteries either inside the device or sent separately in the packaging the Watt-hour rating must not exceed 20Wh per cell or 100Wh per lithium-ion /polymer battery. For lithium metal/alloy







How to Send Batteries in the Post The postal service is not allowed to ship any hazardous materials, including batteries. Lithium batteries are considered dangerous goods because they can explode under certain conditions. This article explains what you can and cannot send in the mail. 
You may only mail lithium batteries: Meeting the conditions outlined in Schedule 2, Special Provision 34 of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations. Subject to the restrictions set out in the table below ; Please note: You aren''t allowed to ship lithium batteries to any destination outside of Canada and the U.S.

Definitions of lithium batteries. The term "lithium battery" or "lithium cell" refers to a family of batteries with different chemistries, comprising many types of cathodes and electrolytes. They are separated into: (I) Lithium ion batteries (Included lithium polymer batteries)


An Post restricts a number of items on both its national and international postal services. These items can only be sent using the Registered Post service, although they may not always be insured. You cannot send restricted items by Standard or Express Post, with the exception of cheques and bank drafts, which can be posted in Ireland by





Under federal law, it is illegal to send these types of ammunition, domestically or internationally, via the U.S. Mail. Small arms ammunition poses a significant danger to Postal employees, equipment, and customers, and you could be subject to civil penalties and criminal charges, if you send them through USPS.

You mail all items at your own risk. Among other exceptions and limitations that may apply, we make no coverage for damages available for shipments containing electronic goods that you ship in any packaging other than: The manufacturer's original packaging, undamaged and retaining its intended shape and strength








No lithium battery markings permitted. Quantities must be within the limits of 622.5 and as outlined below. Lithium-ion batteries properly installed in the equipment they are intended to operate: Mailable internationally when permitted by country, including to and from APO, FPO, and DPO locations. No lithium battery markings permitted.

A table in the Lithium Battery Shipping Regulations manual gives the precise weight of batteries per package on both cargo and passenger aircraft. All marks and labels must be clearly visible on the exterior of all packages and overpacks. Proper marking and labeling is required when shipping lithium batteries by air.

? 3. International Restrictions: International battery shipments have more stringent regulations due to safety concerns. USPS prohibits shipping lithium batteries internationally via mail. However, you can send other non-spillable and spillable batteries internationally, subject to specific packaging requirements and restrictions imposed by the destination country.






Lithium batteries (or equipment containing lithium batteries) are a dangerous good and present a fire and safety risk if carried incorrectly. Lithium-ion batteries under 5 kilos can be transported without a dangerous goods contract, just like any other cargo. Couriers typically accept lithium-ion batteries; however, if you"re transporting lithium metal batteries, you should get in touch with the couriers in advance as they are riskier and rarely accepted.





Lithium batteries, which are commonly used in devices such as mobile phones, laptops, PDAs, watches, cameras, and children's toys, are classified as "Dangerous Goods" under IATA DG Regulations, since charged battery shipments may overheat and ignite under certain conditions.



FedEx takes the transport of your shipment containing lithium batteries very seriously and complies with the International Air Transport Association (IATA) and International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) regulations for carrying such items as a carrier.



Requirements for Sending Electric Toothbrushes via Post. Yes, you can send an electric toothbrush in the post, as long as you adhere to certain mailing requirements and guidelines set by postal services. Labeling: Label the package with "Lithium-ion batteries" if it has rechargeable batteries as these are considered hazardous materials





All of the air freight limitations still apply to shipping lithium battery products via sea freight. Consult with us to be sure if you can send lithium batteries overseas, or domestically.
