

Can You ship lithium batteries to Hawaii?

If you've lived in Hawaii for any length of time, you know that shipping items to the state can present some challenges. Some stores don't ship to Hawaii, while others tack on exorbitant fees. Still others are willing to ship to Hawaii--but exclude certain items. What kind of solutions are available for shipping lithium batteries to Hawaii?

Can I ship a lithium battery by Air Service?

Shipping lithium batteries by air service Regulations differ depending upon what type of lithium battery you are shipping (lithium ion or lithium metal) and whether you are shipping batteries packed with equipment or batteries contained in equipment. Reminder: UPS does not accept Section II shipment

Can I ship a lithium battery cross-border?

There are regulations attached to the cross-border shipping of batteries to ensure they travel safely. These regulations vary depending on the type of batteries. Lithium batteries, for example, are classified as Dangerous Goods, so not all types of lithium batteries are accepted by DHL Express which you can check [here](#).

Can You ship a battery across a country?

Many electronic products and devices contain batteries - in particular, lithium batteries, which are commonly found in laptops, smartphones, tablets, medical devices and power tools. There are regulations attached to the cross-border shipping of batteries to ensure they travel safely. These regulations vary depending on the type of batteries.

Do I need a specific lithium battery Shipping Class?

FedEx Ground strongly recommends that anyone shipping lithium batteries take a specific lithium battery shipping class in order to better understand these complex regulations and meet DOT/ICAO/IATA/IMDG/USPS requirements.

What is a bill of lading for lithium battery shipments to Hawaii?

For lithium battery shipments to Hawaii, the bill of lading must clearly identify the batteries and quantity, and

indicate they are fully regulated Class 9 hazardous materials. The document helps ensure all cargo handlers are aware of the shipment contents and any risks.



If you're shipping lithium ion batteries as a standalone (UN 3480) via air, there are new regulations you need to be aware of. On January 1, 2022, the IATA revised regulations eliminating Section II from PI 965 and PI 968 took effect.



Effective July 1, 2015, all existing customers and new customers who wish to ship lithium metal batteries without equipment (UN3090) via UPS (R) Air services must obtain pre-approval from UPS Airlines. This requirement is to ensure that proper training has occurred and that all applicable safety regulations are properly followed for such shipments.



Shipping lithium batteries by air is possible, but it is crucial to note these are dangerous goods and the applicable regulations must be complied with to ensure the safety of all personnel, aircraft, and passengers. What to know ???

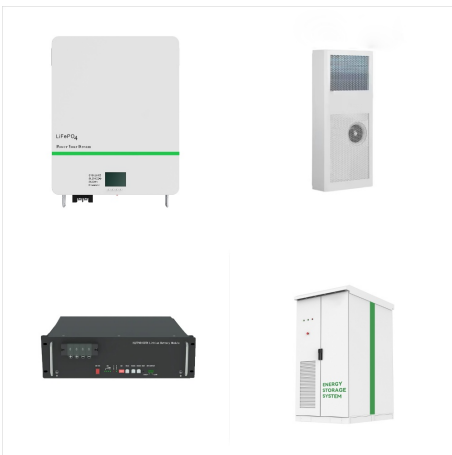

Regional Restrictions for Shipping Lipo Batteries. While UN Model Regulations set the foundation for lithium battery shipping globally, individual countries and regions often have additional and potentially stricter regulations in place. Here are some specific examples of regional restrictions for shipping lithium polymer batteries:



When lithium batteries are integral to the electric scooter or bike, the whole package can ship under the UN 3171 classification, without the need for special hazmat certifications. There are some caveats to this though - the package weight must be under 30kg (66 lbs); and the battery must weigh no more than 5kg (11 lbs).

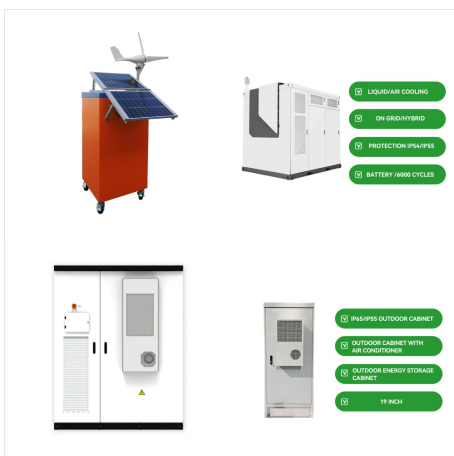

You can ship a lithium-ion battery with 300Wh capacity domestically through any shipping courier, as long as it has the required labels on the outside of the package. However

Except in limited circumstances, pets and warm-blooded animals may not go in the mail. Shipments of live animals, including poultry, reptiles, and bees, have very specific

Some companies will ship to hawaii and others will not. Up to another certain size / capacity, with the right documents / agreements with the carriers, lithium batteries can be shipped via air freight on freight aircraft (hence the marking on the box you refer to). Above that limit they have to be shipped surface (boat) freight, which takes



USPS Packaging Instruction 9E Lithium Metal and Lithium-ion Cells and Batteries ??? International and APO/FPO/DPO. Lithium metal (non-rechargeable) cells and batteries and lithium-ion (rechargeable) cells and batteries are mailable in limited quantities internationally or to and from APO, FPO, or DPO locations only when they are properly installed in the equipment they operate.



So you cannot ship the battery connected to its charger. Even if you are shipping both the bike and the battery, you cannot ship them connected, and will probably be asked to provide separate packaging for the battery. You should also know that lithium batteries cannot be shipped at all if they are damaged. Even minor damage can cause a serious

Evelo charges \$199 shipping fee per bike to Hawaii. They charge \$499 shipping fee per bike to Alaska.

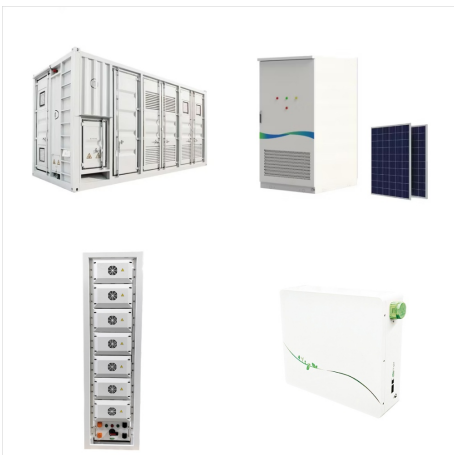

Any package bearing a lithium battery shipping label should also be marked as dangerous goods and have the necessary documentation; It may be necessary to use specialized packaging to ensure the safety; Lithium Metal Batteries These are batteries that use lithium as an anode. They have a long life and can produce anywhere between 1.5V-3.7V.



Officially, yes: Lithium-ion batteries are governed under the United Nations regulations UN3480 and UN3481 as Class 9 "miscellaneous dangerous goods." Two dangers stand out: First, improperly packaged lithium-ion batteries can lead to short circuits if they come into contact with each other or with other conductive surfaces. Second, thermal runaway can occur if improperly ???
