

How many people have access to electricity in Central African Republic?

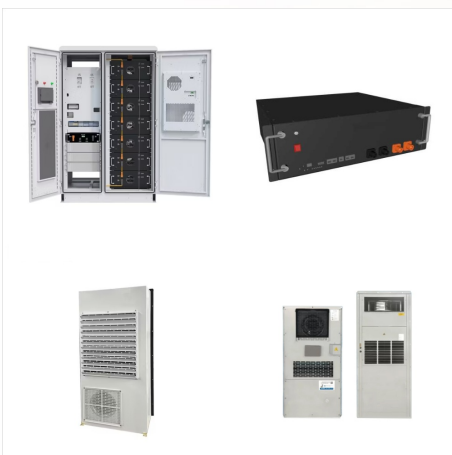
Less than 3% of the population has access to electricity in Central African Republic. Grid-based electricity supply is insufficient to meet electricity demand: it is unavailable 28% of the year on average, mainly due to generation outages.

Did Central African Republic import electricity?

Central African Republic did not import electricity. Power generation, which includes electricity and heat, is one of the largest sources of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions globally, primarily from the burning of fossil fuels like coal and natural gas in thermal power plants.

Sources of electricity generation Electricity can be generated in two main ways: by harnessing the heat from burning fuels or nuclear reactions in the form of steam (thermal power) or by capturing the energy of natural forces such as the sun, wind or moving water.

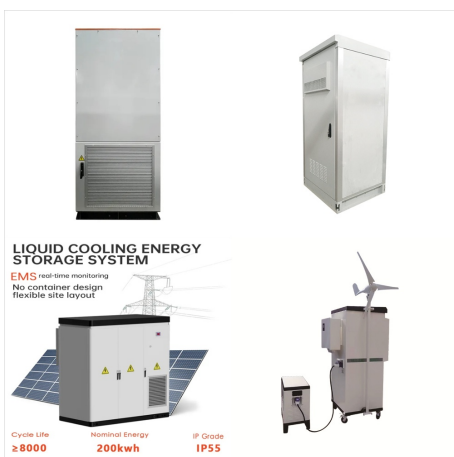

The Central African Republic had a population of 4.7 million people in 2013 (World Bank, 2015). Electricity production in 2015 was 18 ktoe with 88.8 per cent of it generated from hydro. Final electricity consumption in 2015 was 15 ktoe (AFREC, 2015).
