

Who is Citizens Energy?

What is citizens Imperial Valley Solar?

Citizens Imperial Valley Solar is the largest low-income community solar project in the country, serving 12,000 households annually. Citizens Energy uses profits from a transmission line to provide electric vehicles to Native American health centers, charitable organizations and social service agencies in San Diego County.

Who is Citizens for responsible solar?

Citizens for Responsible Solar was founded in an exurb of Washington, D.C., by a longtime political operative named Susan Ralston who worked in the White House under President George W. Bush and still has deep ties to power players in conservative politics. Ralston tapped conservative insiders to help set up and run Citizens for Responsible Solar.

Is Citizens for responsible solar undermining public support for solar?

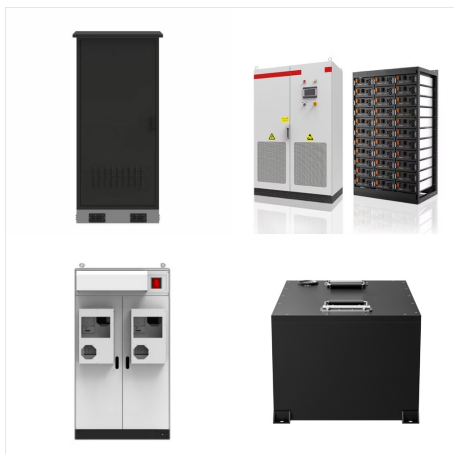

Citizens Solar, a division of Citizens Energy, has completed 30 solar projects to date, with a robust pipeline of projects under development. The completed projects, with a total value of \$225 million, represent 86.1 MW of solar capacity, and produce enough electricity to offset 89,000 tons of carbon annually.

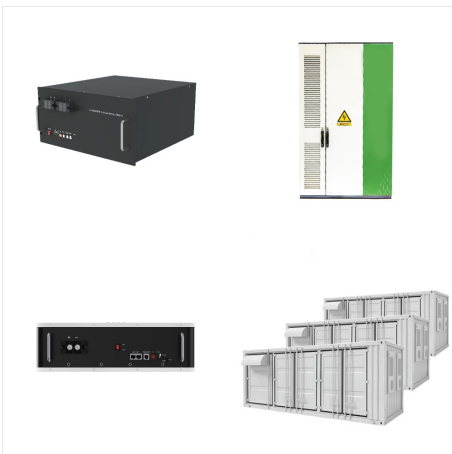

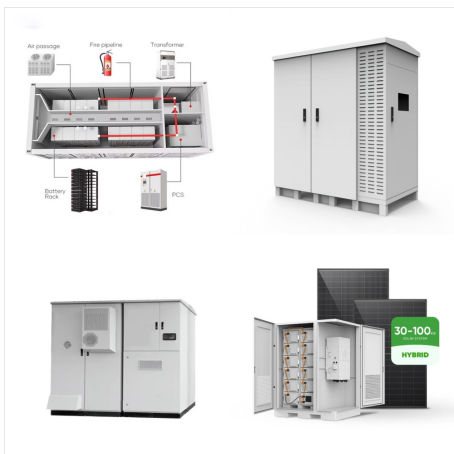
