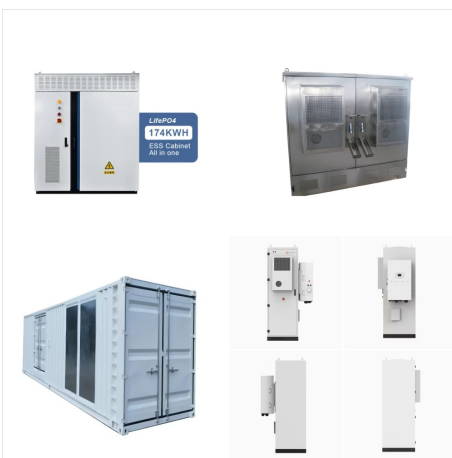

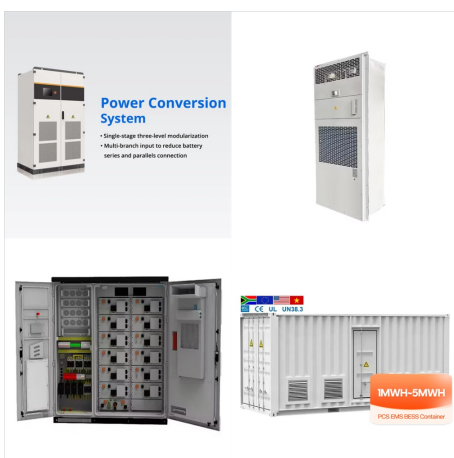

The Columbia Power System is an electrical power distribution system supplying electrical power to consumers located in Columbia, the Town of Spring Hill and parts of rural Maury and Williamson counties in Tennessee. It purchases all electrical power from Tennessee Valley Authority under a power contract.



Junction boxes, troughs, or main breakers are not accepted on the source side of multi-metered developments. To provide CPWS needed access a 40-foot easement on primary and a minimum of 10-foot easement for overhead service conductors will be required.
