Saudi Power Procurement Company (SPPC) is licensed as the sole buyer of electrical energy.

How much will Saudi Arabia spend on energy projects in 2021?

Speaking in 2021, the Saudi government expects to spend \$293 billion on power and energy projects by then. The biggest share of this revenue is expected to be spent on transmission upgrades and renewable energy. The world's largest BESS project in the region shows that the nation is determined to achieve this endeavor. Last week, Prince Abdulaziz revealed that the Kingdom is seeking to establish significant battery energy storage capacity. It is part of the plan to strengthen and expand its electricity infrastructure.

How many Bess facilities are there in Makkah?

The locations of the four BESS facilities have already been decided. Two will be in Makkah province, one in Qassim province, and the other in Hail province. They have also been termed as independent storage projects (ISPs) by SPPC. Qualified bidders have been issued until midday, 25 November 2024, to submit their

proposals for the BESS project.

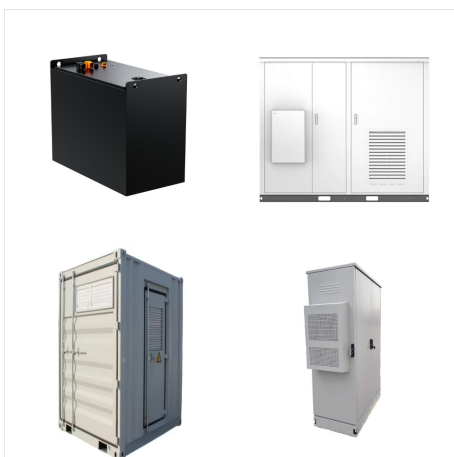

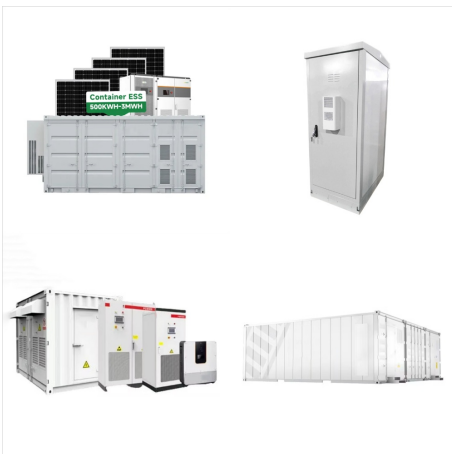

levelized costs of solar electricity (LCOEs) in Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates and Qatar are among the lowest worldwide. Recent tenders ranged from 1.35 to 1.61 cents per kilowatthour (kWh). In 2021, a solar photovoltaic project in Saudi Arabia achieved an LCOE of 1.04 cents/kWh. At this rate, green hydrogen is cheaper to produce than gray
