But he did say he had named two former ministers to the cabinet because experience was needed for the posts of finance and interior minister.

Will Christodoulides reshuffle his cabinet?

In the interview with *Fileleftheros*, the largest daily newspaper in Cyprus, on 31 December Christodoulides said he "would certainly" reshuffle his Cabinet before the first 18 months of his five-year tenure, saying that some ministers "met expectations and some less."
