

The law removes barriers that kept underserved communities from participating in Delaware's community solar program and requiring at least 15-percent of its customers be low-income. Laurel Passera is the senior director of policy and regulatory affairs for the Coalition for Community Solar Access.

Does Delaware have a solar energy program?

In Delaware, residents can claim up to 50% of installation on photovoltaic, solar water heating, and other renewable energy technologies through the state's Green Energy Program. Unfortunately, not all states encourage residential solar deployment.

Are solar panels tax deductible in Delaware?

Delaware homeowners can save thousands on their electricity bills with solar panels, but the 30% federal investment tax credit and local incentives are not included in the installation costs. Going solar in Delaware is easier than ever

Does Delaware require solar metering?

In Delaware,utilities are required to offer full retail net metering to their customers for their solar panel systems. This means that customers will receive the full retail value for each kilowatt-hour (kWh) of energy their solar panels produce. Utilities will issue a credit that will be applied to future electricity bills,helping to reduce costs.






The Public Service Commission regulates public utilities and works to ensure that Delaware consumers are protected.. All owners of solar arrays that are connected to the grid must fill out an application and become certified through the Public Service Commission to be eligible to produce and generate solar renewable energy credits (SRECs).




Thousands of Delawareans currently unable to benefit from the cost savings and low carbon footprint of solar power could soon reap the benefits of renewable energy through a new class of community-solar generating facilities enabled by legislation introduced by Sen. Stephanie Hansen on Thursday.

Solar panels will save you a lot of money over time, but the upfront costs aren"t cheap. The average Delaware homeowner needs a 12.58 kW solar panel system to cover their electricity needs, which comes out to \$30,513 before incentives. Prices range from \$25,936 to \$35,090, but after the federal tax credit, that drops by 30%.

While access laws limit building and zoning restrictions on solar panels, easement laws exist for homeowners to legally maintain their access to adequate sunlight in agreement with other property owners. Delaware Code Title 25 outlines the state's solar access laws which limit an HOA's power to only enforce reasonable restrictions that
