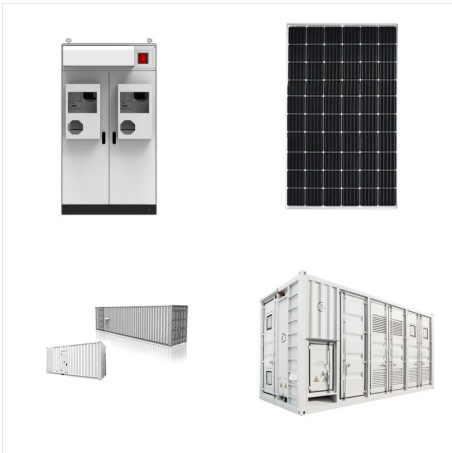
Should I hire a solar panel cleaning service?

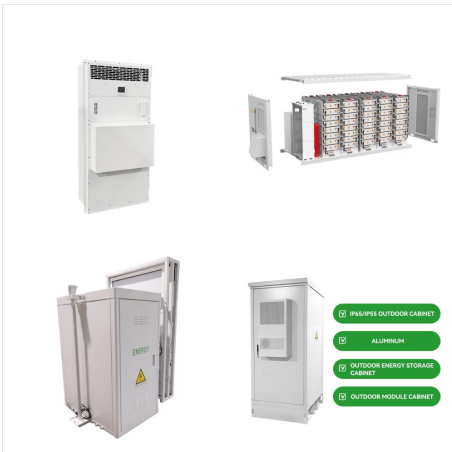

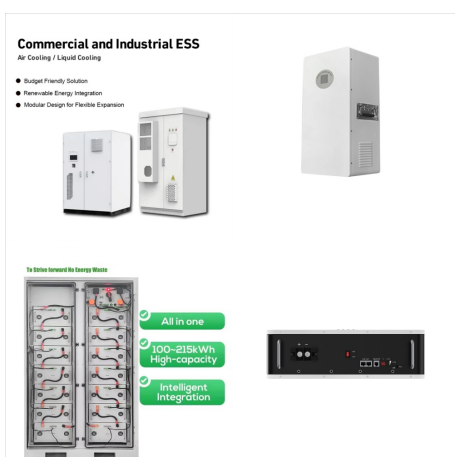

Do not clean your solar panels in direct sunlight. Hire a professional to clean your solar panels if you have a large system. Clean your solar panels more often if you live in an area with a lot of dust or pollen. Be careful not to over-clean your solar panels.



You don't need to wash solar panels regularly in most places in the UK, as solar panels have a hydrophobic coating, meaning rain will do the job. Giving them a proper clean every two or three years is more than enough.

If you cannot clean solar panels safely, do not attempt to get up on your roof. Instead hire a professional who has the correct equipment and knowledge to do so. You should always check with your solar panel manufacturer to see if your panels can be cleaned, without breaking or having an impact on your warranty.



Use baking soda, toothpaste, or dishwashing liquid to clean your solar panels. For harder stains, consider using diluted isopropyl alcohol instead. Do not pressure wash solar panels. Now that the system has been turned off, you can focus on the cleaning work. To clean solar panels, you do not need specialized cleaning equipment.

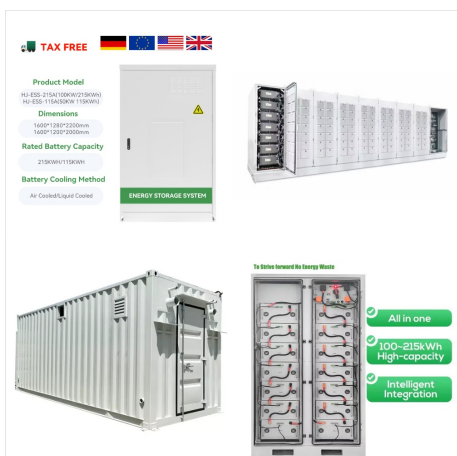

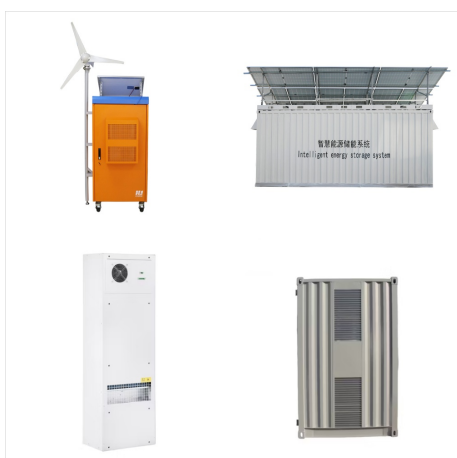
