

Without the power steering system, your Silverado would be very difficult to drive. Most of the weight of the vehicle is absorbed by the power steering system, making it feel much lighter than it really. Silverado brake systems are made up of the following parts: Brake pads; Brake rotors; Calipers; Brake lines; Brake fluid; When you press the brake pedal on your Silverado, you trigger a hydraulic reaction where brake fluid gets sent through the brake lines to the calipers. The rush of brake fluid puts pressure on the calipers and forces them to



Powersteering and brake fluids break down like any other fluid. I typically recommend changing them out every 2 yrs. There is a couple of DIY threads here on the DF about doing the flush for both. From AMSOIL, I would use their universal power steering fluid and their DOT 3 brake fluid. You will need about 6 bottles of each. Take care,

The pedal was pretty firm so I know the MC isnt leaking or losing pressure. I found out that when the hydroboost has a leak it can cause the piston not to fully retract, leaving it partially engaged with the MC which can lead to the hard pedal feeling and the pressure on the brake system causing the brakes to drag or lock up.
