How many employees does Nordex have in Spain?

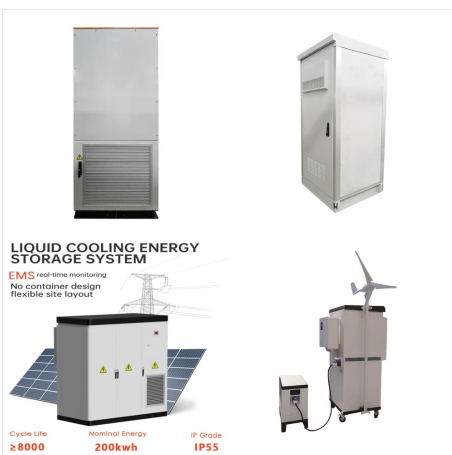
