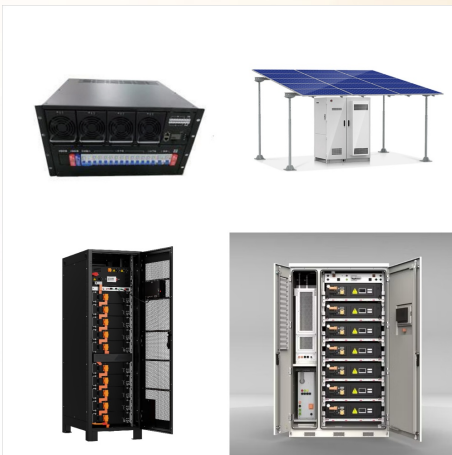




European Energy, a global leader in renewable energy development, is ready to start construction of its first solar park in Latvia. This ambitious project, spanning 138 hectares ???



Renewables company European Energy announced October 3 it is ready to start construction of its first solar park in Latvia. The ambitious project, spanning 138 hectares in T??rgale, Ventspils county, will boast a substantial capacity of 148 MW, making it one of the largest solar parks in the country.



A landscaping scheme will be implemented to screen the solar farm from neighbouring residences and roads, and to help embed it into the surrounding landscape. Drombeg Solar Farm will connect to the electricity grid through a new 110kV substation on the solar farm site that will loop into an existing overhead line that traverses the site.



Denmark-based European Energy will soon commence construction on its first solar farm in Latvia, a 148 MW facility featuring 240,000 solar panels near Targale in Ventspils County. Upon completion, the project will generate 154,550 MWh annually, supplying electricity to around 40,000 European households.



Set to become one of the largest PV farms in Latvia, the new plant is expected to start feeding power to the grid by the end of next year. The capacity will be installed near the village of Targale in western Latvia's Ventspils County and is expected to generate about 154,550 MWh of electricity annually.



The solar farm will have a capacity of 148 MW once completed, which will make it one of the largest solar farms in the country. The solar farm will be located near Targale in Ventspils County. Upon completion, it will be able to produce around 154,550 MWh annually, providing electricity equivalent to the household consumption of approximately
