Did a storm break the electric grid?

Intense cold strained, but didn't break, the U.S. electric grid. That was lucky Transmission towers in Houston as the storm carrying frigid temperatures approached. The storm tested the reliability of the grid in Texas and across the country, but did not trigger a widespread power crisis.

What if a storm hits North America's power grid?

JUANA SUMMERS, HOST: North America's power grid is vulnerable. A new assessment finds that if a major storm hits this winter, about two-thirds of the U.S. and Canada could face energy shortages and outages. People living in Southwestern states are at particular risk.

Is summer heat hurting the US power grid?
