

Dispatch,a Dutch battery developer,is going to construct the Netherlands' largest stand-alone Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) in the port area of Dordrecht. The system will be used for grid stabilization by storing excess energy from renewable sources. The battery, consisting of 144 Fluence cubes will be located on a 6000m² site.

How many energy storage facilities are there in the Netherlands?

The vast majority of the 20 MW of installed energy storage capacity in the Netherlands is spread over just three facilities: the Netherlands Advancion Energy Storage Array (10 MW Li-ion), the Amsterdam ArenA (4 MW Li-ion), and the Bonaire Wind-Diesel Hybrid project (3 MW Ni-Cad battery).

What is the Netherlands Advancion energy storage array?

The Netherlands Advancion Energy Storage Array was commissioned in late 2015 and provides 10 MWh of storage to Dutch transmission system operator TenneT. The project, which represents 50% of all Dutch energy storage capacity, provides frequency regulation by using power stored in its batteries to respond to grid imbalances.

What will equans Netherlands do for Eneco?

Equans Netherlands will take charge of the engineering and construction of the battery storage system. Eneco will use the battery on a long-term basis to manage differences in supply and demand in energy markets.

How much energy does a Bess battery storage system store?

The 45MW/90Mh utility-scale BESS will on average store enough energy supply equivalent for 21.500 households per day. Construction is set to commence in the coming months. Equans Netherlands will take charge of the engineering and construction of the battery storage system.

Why do we need energy storage?

With energy storage, we can better absorb these fluctuations in the future energy system. Energy storage, in whatever form, serves as a buffer between supply and demand, ensuring the system remains reliable.





The hybrid system combines 8.8MW / 7.12MWh of lithium-ion batteries with six flywheels adding up to 3MW of power. It will provide 9MW of frequency stabilising primary control power to the transmission grid operated by TenneT and is located in Almelo, a city in the Overijssel province in the east Netherlands.



Also now underway is a project in the Netherlands where Thermal Batteries charged with renewable energy will replace natural gas. Lumenion founder and CEO Alexander Voigt, a pioneering veteran of Germany's solar industry, told Energy-Storage.news at the time that his company's systems, storing energy as heat in steel at up to 650?C,

Construction is expected to begin in the third quarter of this year and testing will commence in Q2 2022.
