Through the photovoltaic effect, your solar panels produce a one-directional electrical current, called direct current (DC) electricity.

How do solar panels work?

You're likely most familiar with PV, which is utilized in solar panels. When the sun shines onto a solar panel, energy from the sunlight is absorbed by the PV cells in the panel. This energy creates electrical charges that move in response to an internal electrical field in the cell, causing electricity to flow.

How are solar panels made?

Traditional solar cells are made using a single material to absorb sunlight. Currently, almost all solar panels are made from silicon- the same material at the core of microchips. While silicon is a mature and reliable material, its efficiency is limited to about 29%.

How do solar cells generate electricity?

When photons hit the solar cells they create an electric fieldat the junction between the layers. This electric field knocks electrons loose from the atoms in solar cells, setting them in motion. The electrons flow through the solar cell and out of the junction, generating an electrical current.

How efficient are solar panels?

The second and most significant is the relentless increase in the panels' power conversion efficiency - a measure of how much sunlight can be transformed into electricity. The higher the efficiency of solar panels, the cheaper the electricity. This might make you wonder: just how efficient can we expect solar energy to become?

How do solar panels convert solar energy into heat?

Instead,the solar panels,known as "collectors," transform solar energy into heat. Sunlight passes through a collector's glass covering,striking a component called an absorber plate,which has a coating designed to capture solar energy and convert it to heat.




