The business and technology that LSI is selling to NetApp (aka Engenio) is the external storage system business that accounted for about \$705M of their approximate \$900M+ storage business in 2010. This piece of the business represents external (outside of the server) shared RAID storage systems that support Serial Attached SCSI (SAS),

A lot has changed since Engenio backed off because it didn't like the price of preliminary bids on its stock. For now, the company remains a division of LSI Logic Corp. (NYSE: LSI), which said in November 2003 it would spin off its storage unit, christening it Engenio (see LSI Logic Spins Off Storage Systems and LSI Spells Engenio).

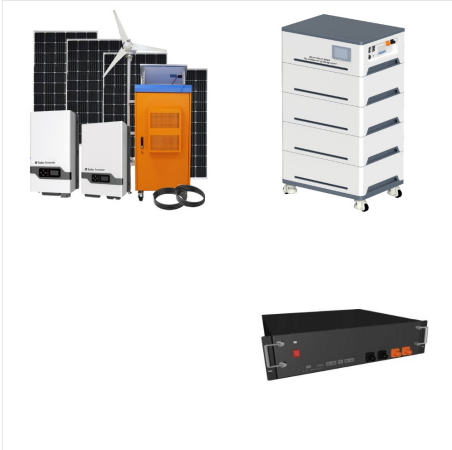
