



What is the Island Innovator Rig doing in Equatorial Guinea?

The Island Innovator rig has arrived in Equatorial Guinea for a nine-month contract with Trident Energy, primarily on infill drilling.

What's going on at Block G in Equatorial Guinea?

The three-well infill drilling campaign at Equatorial Guinea's offshore Block G - operated by Trident Energy, with partners Panoro, Kosmos Energy and GEPetrol - has started, using the Island Innovator semi-submersible drilling rig.

How much energy does Equatorial Guinea use?

Electricity consumption in Equatorial Guinea in 2015 was 36 kilotonnes of oil equivalent (ktoe). The country produces all of the energy it consumes. As of 2012, renewable energy accounted for 29.2% of the final energy mix.

Will Trident drill in Equatorial Guinea?

As a result, the drilling company said the rig would be in Equatorial Guinea for around 230 days. Trident also has another two options it could exercise. Before heading to West Africa, the Island Innovator was working for Dana Petroleum in the UK. Trident and Kosmos bought their Equatorial Guinea assets from Hess in 2017.

Who is the Director General of hydrocarbons in Equatorial Guinea?

The director general of hydrocarbons, Robustiano Ndong Eyegue, and head of refined products, Francisco Ndong Ayong, represented the ministry at Luba for the rig's arrival. Equatorial Guinea's Ministry of Hydrocarbons said the rig would carry out three wells for Trident, in addition to an exploration well.

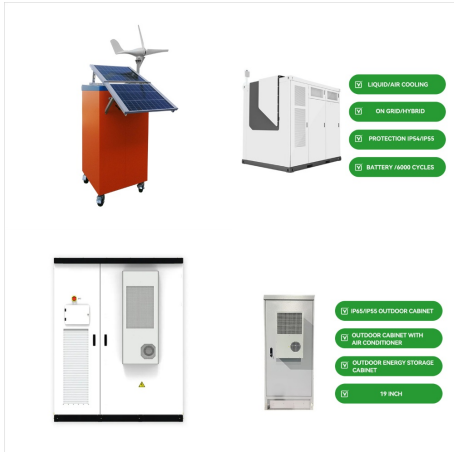


Panoro Energy ASA has announced that it has entered into agreements with Tullow Oil plc and its subsidiaries to acquire high-quality oil producing assets offshore Equatorial Guinea and Gabon for an initial aggregate cash consideration of up to US\$140mn and aggregate contingent consideration of up to US\$40mn, based on an effective date of 1 July 2020.



ExxonMobil also supported the Grassroots Soccer program, which delivers a malaria prevention and sports curriculum in Equatorial Guinea. Nor has ExxonMobil stopped with helping humans. It has provided considerable support for the Bioko Biodiversity Protection Program (BBPP) for more than 15 years.
