Is fidelity environment & alternative Engy a good investment?

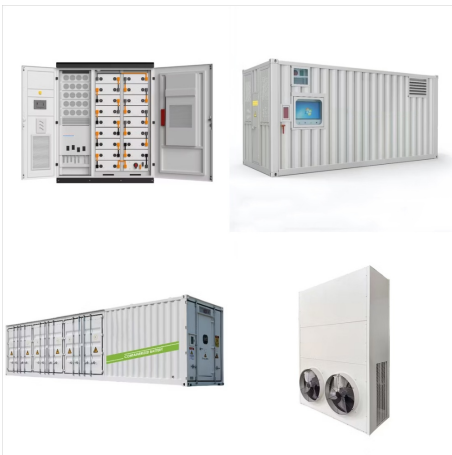

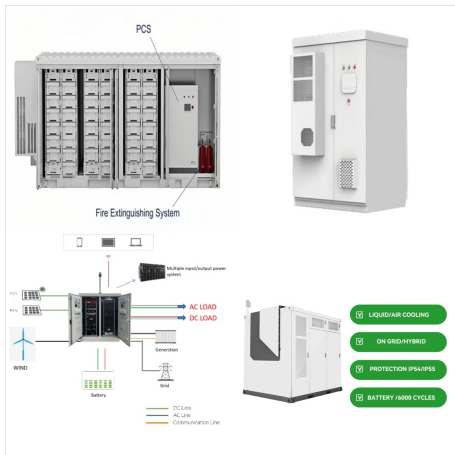
