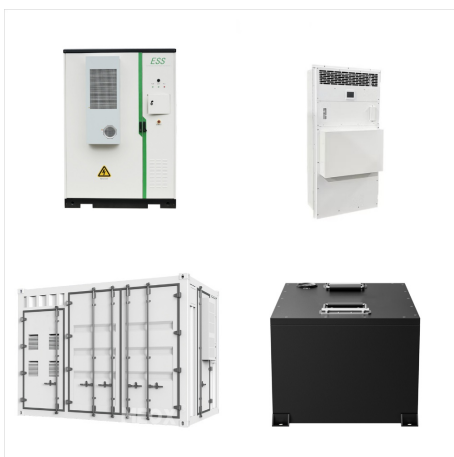

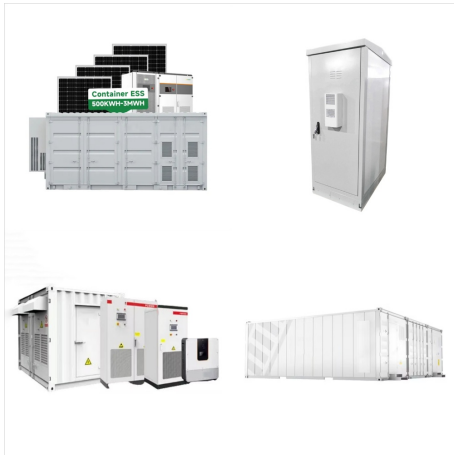

1. Three Available Configurations. There are three different levels of Pro Power Onboard available. These include a 2.0 kW system on any gas-fired F-150 engine except for the standard 3.3 liter V-6, a 2.4 kW system standard on the F-150 hybrid, and an optional 7.2 kW system only available on the hybrid.

An onboard generator on a pickup truck seems like an obvious feature. Until the release of the 2021 Ford F-150, however, such a feature didn't exist. Touted as one of the main reasons to go with a Ford over the competition, the Pro Power Onboard generator can serve a variety of uses. Some folks will use it for work.



"Right now, the traditional outlets provide 150 or 400 watts of power. So basically, we are providing like five times more than that," Nigar Sultana, the engineer in charge of Pro Power Onboard, said. Three different onboard generator systems are available.



The Ford F-150 onboard generator converts your engine into a generator that provides power to an inverter, producing energy to power several appliances. Providing more exportable power than any light-duty full-size pickup, the onboard generator offers three levels of electrical output depending on engine choice:



Pro Power Onboard has vehicle mounted inverters, which are capable of generating 2 kW, 2.4 kW or 7.2 kW of output power. The output from the inverters are consistent and reliable power, which does not rely on the engine speed.

The 2.0-kW Pro Power Onboard generator will be a \$995 option. This is the least powerful system (equal to the Honda EU2000i) and is available with any 2021 Ford F-150, except the 3.3-liter V6. You can also start and stop the Pro Power generator with Ford's FordPass smartphone app effectively giving you the convenience of a generator built



The all-new 2021 Ford F-150 is packed with innovative features and cool tech, and that includes its ability to act essentially as a portable generator thanks to its Pro Power Onboard electrical system.

Plus, Ford has two other smaller-powered OnBoard generators for their trucks including a 7.2 kW (for the hybrid F-150) and 2.4 kW for the ICE-powered F-150 (2.7-liter and 3.5-liter EcoBoost engines). In an apples-to-apples comparison, this is where F-150 retains the edge over the Silverado since this generator is only available on the EV
