Examples of renewable energy sources include wind power, solar power, bioenergy (organic matter burned as a fuel) and hydroelectric, including tidal energy.



Energy sources are categorized into renewable and nonrenewable types. Nonrenewable energy sources are those that exist in a fixed amount and involve energy transformation that cannot be easily replaced. Renewable energy sources are those that can be replenished naturally, at or near the rate of consumption, and reused.
