

After grants, worked out about 11k. We had 10 panels put in. As mentioned above, prices do seem to be quite variable. The 11k was the second cheapest we got, not the cheapest, but they were able to slot us in within a short time rather than the two to three months wait other installers had suggested - that would have put us online after summer.
