Here's how to use Genmoji on iPhone to create your own custom emoji. Note that before you use Apple Intelligence, you have to request it for your iPhone. To do so, go to Settings > Apple Intelligence & Siri and tap Get Apple Intelligence. 1. Open Messages and go into a chat. 2.

What is Apple intelligence genmoji?

Genmoji is Apple's new generative AI feature that creates custom emojis on the fly from whatever prompt you ask for - think Apple's Memoji, but better. How do I create a genmoji based on a photo?

To create a Genmoji based on a photo, enter the name of a person you've identified in your photo library, add a description -- "Danny celebrating his 35th birthday," for example -- tap Choose a Person, select a person identified in your Photos library, then choose a variation.

How do I remove a genmoji from a text?

Tap a text field, then tap or to switch to the emoji keyboard. Swipe right or tap . Tap , touch and hold a Genmoji, then tap Remove. You can also tap in a Messages conversation, tap Stickers, touch and hold a Genmoji, then tap Remove. *Apple Intelligence uses generative models and outputs may vary. 


