

Are there free solar panels in Massachusetts?

There are several programs that offer free solar panels and installations to Massachusetts residents. ? Solar panels will save you a lot of money over time, but the upfront costs aren't cheap. The average Massachusetts homeowner needs a 10.37 kW solar panel system to cover their electricity needs, which comes out to \$33,372 before incentives.



SMART Program (Solar Massachusetts Renewable Target) The SMART program is another way to earn money from your solar system. Through this program, you get paid for the energy your solar panels produce. For every kilowatt-hour (kWh) of energy, you can earn between \$0.19 and \$0.31, depending on where you are located in the state.
