

Is biomass a source of electricity in French Polynesia?

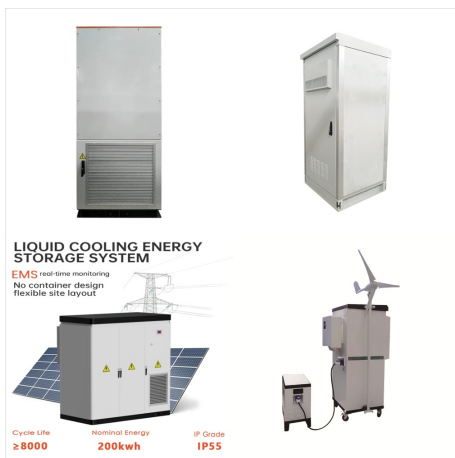

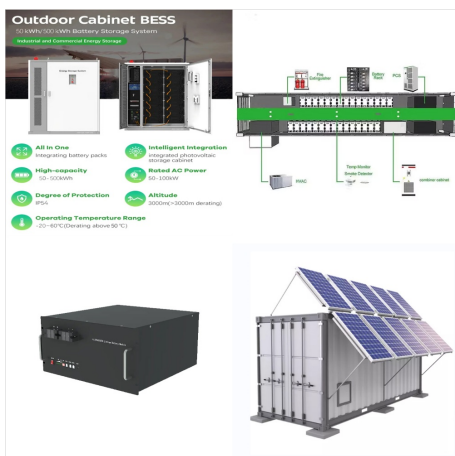
