

What is a Generac generator?

How does a Generac home backup generator work?

Can a Generac generator run on natural gas?

Generac's residential generators can run on natural gas, liquid propane (LP), or diesel. However, if you can, use natural gas. You won't have to worry about where to store fuel or what happens if you run out before the outage ends. LP is a solid second choice, but like diesel, you'll need a large container to store it in.

How much propane does a Generac generator use?

Depending on what size home you have, and what size propane tank you have, you might want a smaller or larger generator. Fuel consumption for Generac generators can range from 0.87 gallons of propane per hour

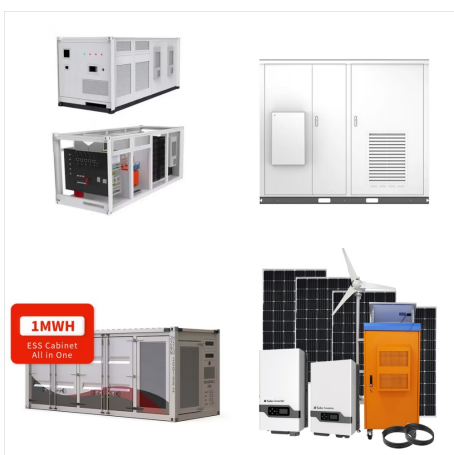
to 3.63 for common household sized generators. The most common Generac generator size houses will use is one of the Generac 26kw models.
