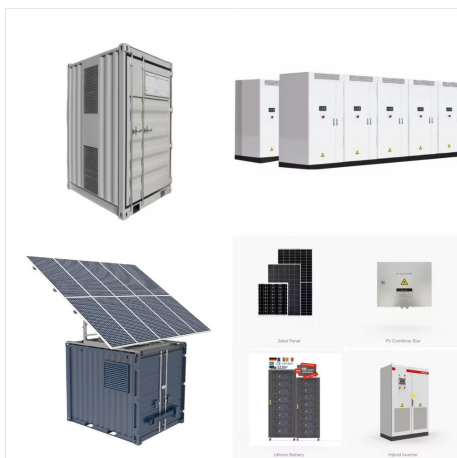

Two companies reported a loss - TransnetBW GmbH (EUR -53.6M) and Uniper SE (EUR -4.6B).

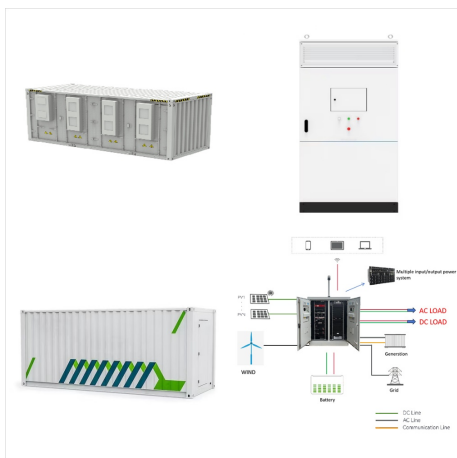

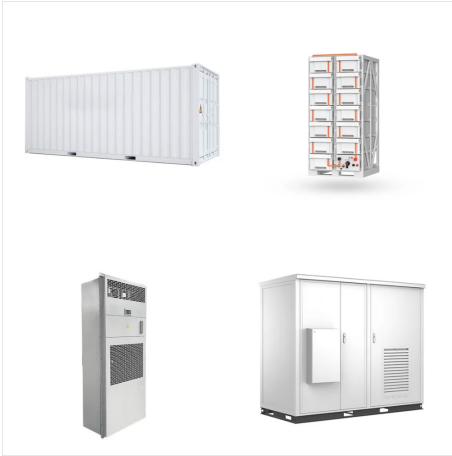
