

What are Glasgow City Council's New grey recycling bins?

As part of the changes, residents are urged to recycle only paper, card and cardboard only in the blue bin. Glasgow City Council are to introduce new grey recycling bins as of next month. Glasgow City Council is to begin a phased introduction of new grey recycling bins next month that will be fitted with tracking devices.

What recycling bins are in Glasgow?

Everything you need to know about recycling in Glasgow: The blue bin is the most confusing and yet versatile of all the bins. It's for paper, card, plastic bottles, food and drink cans and empty aerosol cans and it's collected once a fortnight. Food and drink cans - steel cans, aluminium cans and food tins.

How long does it take to get a new recycling bin in Glasgow?

The delivery of the extra bin will begin this summer and will take roughly 9-12 months to complete, after the local authority approved plans to adopt a new contamination policy at the city administration committee on Thursday. Why is there a new recycling bin being introduced in Glasgow?

Is Glasgow a good place to recycle?

Glasgow City Council is one of the worst places in the UK for recycling. Figures show less than a quarter of waste collected in the city is being recycled. In 2018, Glasgow sent the most waste to landfill of any authority in Scotland at more than 167,000 tonnes and the council recycled just over 60,000 tonnes of it.

Why are new recycling bins coming to Glasgow this summer?

New recycling bins are set to be delivered to households in Glasgow this summer, as part of a drive to stop people putting their recycling in the wrong containers. It was revealed that households failing to properly separate their recycling into the correct bins was costing the council an estimated £3 million a year.

Where is general waste processed in Glasgow?

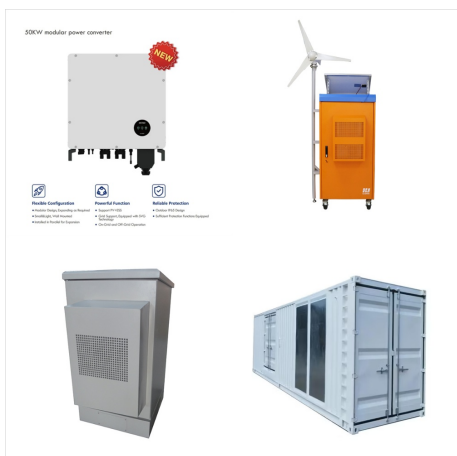

But with twin stream recycling being introduced through the on-street bin hubs and also for kerbside collections, there are clear signs we are turning the corner on Glasgow's record on recycling." The ?7.2m investment agreed by the council for on-street bin hubs will go towards procuring 4800 1280 litre bins and 1200 units to house those bins.

Commercial waste will not be accepted at our Household Waste Recycling Centre. Commercial Waste must go via the Weighbridge where you will be charged (see Weighbridge below) All household recycling waste is subject to a visual inspection by on-site staff and you may be asked to provide proof of where the waste came from.
