

Does France have territories in the Indian Ocean?

But at the subregional scale, France is doubtless a major player in the two zones where it has territories. French territories in the Indian Ocean (Reunion, Mayotte and the French Southern and Antarctic Lands) are located in the southwestern quarter, near the Mozambique Channel.

Does France have a strategic partnership with the Indo-Pacific axis?

France has a strategic partnershipwith the three allies of its Indo-Pacific axis, which allows for in-depth dialogue on defense and security issues. The Trilateral Dialogue on the Indo-Pacific (France, India, Australia) was launched in 2020. France also takes part in joint exercises, essential for interoperability and protecting common interests.

Are French territories stable in the Indo-Pacific?

While French territories in the Indo-Pacific are mostly stable, their environment is not. France has to contend with territorial disputes (Comoros on Mayotte, Mauritius on the island of Tromelin and Vanuatu on the islands of Matthews and Hunter), as well as China's continuous trafficking and military provocations.



French Southern Territories, comprising of several islands in the Indian Ocean, are isolated with a harsh climate, making technology and telecommunications development challenging. The territories have no indigenous population, with only temporary French military personnel, scientists, officials and support staff residing.
