Some states and communities have already had Solar for All programs, but the \$7 billion in grants authorized by the Inflation Reduction Act and awarded this week by the US Environmental Protection Agency will allow for a national adoption of the model. What is Solar for All?

Does the US government buy solar panels?

Who will receive a \$7 billion solar grant?

Washington - Today, April 22, as the Biden-Harris Administration celebrates Earth Day, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency announced 60 selectees that will receive \$7 billion in grant awards through the Solar for All grant competition to deliver residential solar projects to over 900,000 households nationwide.

While "free solar panel" offers are common, that's usually not the whole story. Often, it's actually a solar lease or power purchase agreement with \$0 down, meaning "free" only lasts until the first monthly payment is due. Under these solar financing agreements, a solar company installs solar panels on your home for no money down (hence, the misleading use of the word "free"), and you then either pay a monthly rate for the clean energy those panels produce, or you pay to rent the panels rather than paying for the energy they generate. Although the concept of "free solar panels" might seem enticing, it's important to understand that there are no direct government programs or companies offering completely free solar panels. However, the government does provide various incentives and financial assistance programs to make solar panels more affordable and accessible for



The solar panels and inverter must be on the lists of Clean Energy Council approved modules and inverters. You usually don"t need to provide any assets as security to apply for a state, territory or local government loan scheme. Interest-free loans are repaid over a set period (usually in fortnightly or monthly instalments) and depend on

Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) The most common path to "free" solar is a Power Purchase Agreement directly between you and a state-licensed solar energy company. Under a "PPA", the solar company absorbs the full cost of the solar panel equipment and installation for you. The solar company is technically the owner of the equipment, however, they are ???



The process depends on the state you live in, so be sure to check the laws where you live to make sure that you qualify.





Ways of Government Funding for Free Solar Panels. State-funded financing for free solar systems can occur through various programs and initiatives aimed at supporting the use of renewable energy sources. Solar panel companies most often enter into special agreements, which we will discuss in more detail.



The eligibility criteria for solar panel grants differ significantly depending on the specific program. For instance, in order to qualify, you might need to reside in a specific area or type of property, meet certain income or financial criteria, or live in a building with a low energy efficiency rating.



"Free solar panels" aren"t free; typically, these programs refer to solar leases or PPAs. The federal government does not provide free solar panels, but does provide incentives that reduce the cost of going solar. You can go solar with no upfront cost by taking out a \$0-down loan, signing a lease or PPA, or subscribing to a community solar farm.
