The Prime Minister had launched the scheme on 13th February, 2024. The major highlights of the scheme include: Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for Residential Rooftop Solar. The scheme provides a CFA of 60% of system cost for 2 kW systems and 40% of additional system cost for systems between 2 to 3 kW capacity. The CFA will be capped at 3 kW.





Government policies like the Small-scale Renewable Energy Scheme (SRES), Renewable Energy Target (RET), and state-based incentives help to lower the high upfront cost, increasing solar energy adoption. To promote the adoption of solar energy, the federal government provides several performance-based incentives.



The scheme was first announced by finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman during the Interim Budget 2024-"25. Modi said that under the solar panel scheme, substantive subsidies will be provided to the beneficiaries of the scheme and that they will be transferred directly to their bank accounts.
