The implementation of a battery energy storage system will allow Cura?ao to collect energy from renewable sources such as wind and solar energy and store it using advanced battery storage technologies.

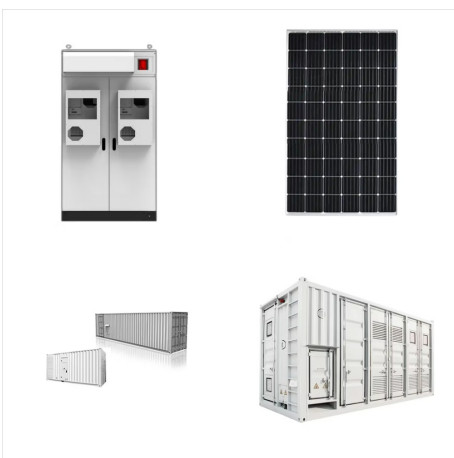
